Our construction team will be on leave from Friday 18 December 2020 and will start returning in the new year from Monday 4 January 2021. The operations team will be working through the break to support the Plant's ongoing service and operations.

Achievements

In November the project team reached an important milestone in which the project added capacity in time for the summer peak to ensure the required level of service during the area's busy season. Below is the team standing on the Moving Bed Bio-Reactor (MBBR) on the day this milestone was reached.



Other recent project milestones include:

- 3.2km of underground pipework installed.
- The building modifications to the existing tanker receival building.
- The Thickening building pumps are installed, and the inlet chamber's mechanical works are complete.
- The Anoxic Tank and Tertiary Treatment Plant (TTP) are both complete.

For the reminder of December and during January our team will be focused on the following work:

- Mechanical and electrical completion activities around the plant
- Commence Hardscape and Pavements
- Install cladding on the digester tanks
- Complete stormwater installation
