

Boneo Water Recycling Plant

Project update - June

Work continues to progress for the Boneo Water Recycling Plant upgrade. A smaller team is working on site with a focus on mechanical and electrical works and commissioning the new Plant operations.

A major project milestone was reached in June with the Plant's rising mains migrated to the new Inlet area. The team will now decommission the old inlet works. The team also commissioned the new odour control system.

Plant upgrades

We are very proud of the Plant we are building. Below is an insight into some of the new operational areas and how they contributing to a reduced carbon footprint.

The new Fats, Oil and Greases Acceptance Facility. The facility takes product from various sources and processes it to create a gas which powers a generator that provides power to the site.



The new Tanker Receiving Facility accepts waste from external septic trucks. The product is then treated and recycled on site.



Upcoming works

In July the team will:

- complete the new Recycled Water Treatment Plant,
- continue to commission new areas of the Plant.
- commence pavement works across the site
- start demolishing redundant plant.

The majority of works over the coming months will involve work inside the new Plant (mechanical and electrical works) and commissioning activities.

Works are expected to be completed in late 2021, which includes site sheds and offices removed offsite and areas disrupted by the construction activities reinstated.
